The School is an unaided institution and prepares students for the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) and Indian School Certificate (ISC) Examination, affiliated to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination (CISCE), New Delhi.

Parents can meet the teachers on any other day with prior appointment.

All correspondence should be carried out through the school office regarding the child. Parents should mention the student's name, the standard and the division in which the student is studying in all correspondence, related to the school.

Parent's signature in the diary would indicate that the rules and remarks entered by the school authorities have been noted.

Parents are specially requested to notify the school of any change in their address, telephone number or mobile number.

Parents are requested to refrain from giving large amount of cash as pocket money to their children, as we wish to inculcate the habit of thrift among the students.

Parents are requested to fill the Health Form and Personal Memorandum provided in the diary. Copies of medical certificates should be attached to the form and submitted to the class teacher on or before 15th June, 2026.

Parents are expected to encourage regularity and discipline and see that their children do their homework.

Students of the Primary Section leave school by 5.45 p.m. after which the students who are not picked up by the parents will be left under the care of the security guards.

Mobile Phones: Students of Std. I to IX are not permitted to carry mobile phones to school. If found by the authorities, they will be confiscated and will not be returned. Students of X and ISC are permitted to carry calling phones but not allowed to use it within school working hours. During an emergency, students are permitted to use the school phone.

Students are advised to refrain from making any obscene comments on friends, staff or school on the Social Network. The school will not be responsible for any undue trouble. Strict action will be taken on students getting involved in such activities.

Bullying of any kind – verbal, physical, social or cyber is strictly prohibited in our school. Any form of bullying will result in immediate investigation & strict consequences in accordance with school's disciplinary policies. Students are encouraged to report any incidents of bullying to a Teacher, Counsellor or school authority.

Birthday gifts should not exceed a value of Rs.30 for students of Std. I to Std. XII.
